# PROCLAMATION

National Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month  
2025

**Whereas**, in 1987, President Ronald Reagan recognized Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month to "increase public awareness of the needs and the potential of Americans who face developmental disabilities and to provide the opportunities they need in order to live productive lives and to achieve their full potential"; and

**Whereas**, developmental disabilities are defined as impairments in physical, learning, language, or behavioral areas, which include Autism spectrum disorders, Cerebral Palsy, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder, intellectual or learning disabilities, hearing loss, vision impairment, and other developmental delays; and

**Whereas**, nationally one in six children between the ages of three and seventeen have one or more developmental disabilities, and 13% of the population in Kittitas County and Washington state live with disabilities; and

**Whereas**, Central Washington Disability Resources (CWDR), located in Ellensburg, is the resource agency for people with disabilities of any age and provides case management, developmental disability support groups, therapeutic swim program, skills training, counseling, assistance with housing, attendant care, and advocacy; and

**Whereas**, the mission of the Kittitas County Developmental Disabilities Advisory Committee is to foster an inclusive environment that supports residents with developmental disabilities and their families to participate in and contribute to all aspects of the community.

**Now, therefore**, the City of Ellensburg does hereby proclaim March as Developmental Disabilities Awareness month and encourages community members to support local agencies such as Central Washington Disability Resources by volunteering and finding ways to serve, promoting inclusivity in schools, workplaces, and community events, and engaging with persons with disabilities and listening to their life experiences.
