PROCLAMATION

National Women's History Month and International Women's Day
March 2025

Whereas, President Jimmy Carter signed a 1981 presidential proclamation designating the week of March 8 as National Women's History Week; and

Whereas, the 1987 United States Congress passed Public Law 100-9, declaring the month of March as National Women's History Month; and

Whereas, the goal of National Women's History Month is an intentioned time period to honor and celebrate women's often-overlooked social, economic, and political, cultural contributions to American history; and to recognize all the women who work for equity, diversity and belonging; and

Whereas, International Women's Day, first recognized by the United Nations in 1977 is a vital part of National Women's History month; and


Whereas, International Women's Day is an annual, global celebration of all women and their contributions to the cultural, social, economic, and political structures of this world, as well as recommitment from all nations to a peaceful, diverse, equitable, and inclusive world; and

Whereas, the City of Ellensburg recognizes and honors all of the women, past and present, and their significant efforts in making Ellensburg a strong and vibrant Central Washington City.

Now, Therefore, the City Council of the City of Ellensburg does hereby proclaim March 2025 as Women's History Month and March 8, 2025 as International Women's Day in Ellensburg. We are grateful to all women who support this community through their daily activities, and we encourage all residents to honor, celebrate, and thank these women for their efforts.
